

A checklist for home and woodland owners to prepare for the 2020 wildfire season

Note: Flammable Debris (FD) includes pine needles, dry grass, downed twigs and logs, and other flammable woody materials that can be an ignition source or spread source of wildfire.

Are the closest 3-5' of your yard completely FD free?		
Are your roof, gutters, and eaves FD free?		
Is there dense vegetation or dead wood within 30' of your home?		
Are eaves, fascia and soffits clear of FD and screened in?		
Are there spark arrestors installed on your chimneys?		
Is your house number visible from the road on your mailbox and home?		
Is your driveway accessible for fire equipment if necessary?		
Yard (within 30 ft. of home)	Yes	No
Is your lawn mowed?		
Are your trees pruned 6 to 10' from the ground?		
Is leaf litter, twigs, downed logs, or other FD present on your yard?		
Are tree branches touching the house?		
Is there firewood stored adjacent to your home or underneath a deck?		
Have you checked your irrigation system this season?		
Is your yard watered and green?		
Are flammable liquids such as gasoline or oil stored properly?		
Are your tree crowns touching one another?
